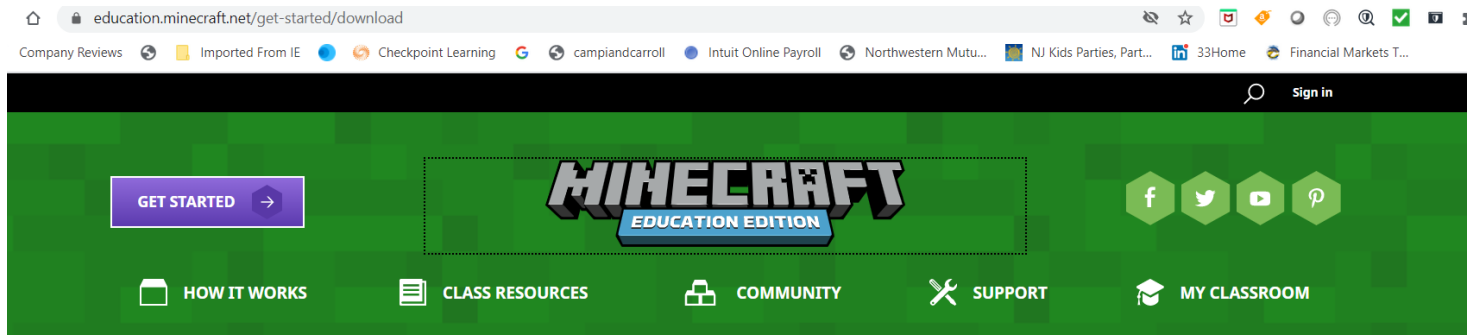


Minecraft Pre-Class Instructions:

Any computer may be used to install Minecraft Education software and installations are simple. To receive Tech Support you will need to use a Chromebook with Minecraft Education version. If you are using a school issued Chromebook, then the School will remotely install Minecraft once you send a request to admin@cc4steam.org

If using your own personal computer, you will need to download Minecraft Microsoft Education version to your computer. Here is the link for the application: <https://education.minecraft.net/get-started/download> The website will detect which version is appropriate for your computer.

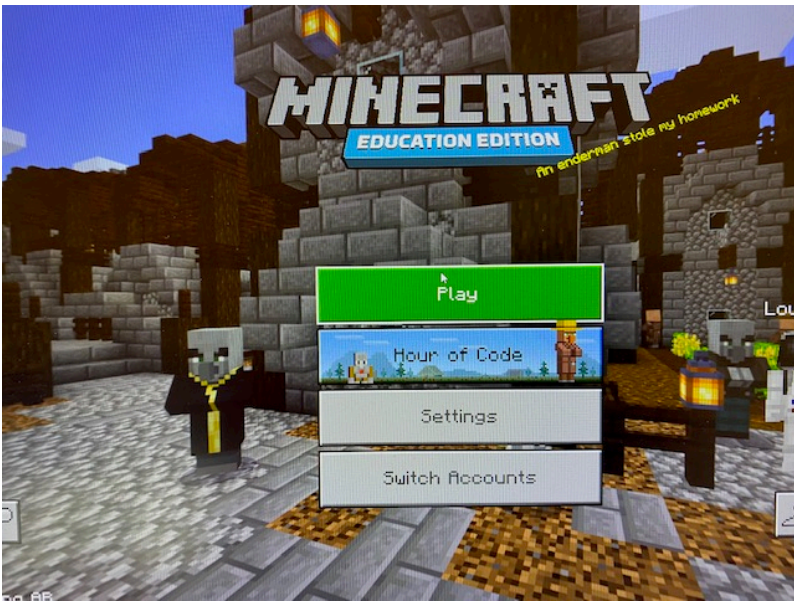

After you click on the link it will prompt you to install the application. You will be provided with a user id and password, so there is no need to pay for Minecraft. If at any time, you are asked to provide payment information, you should choose the option to bypass that.

Once Minecraft is installed, we recommend trying the user tutorial because the keyboard commands in the Education version are different. You should also make sure your mouse allows you to use left click and right click commands (some Chromebook touchpads may not work and you will need to plugin a mouse to your computer). Below are the screen shots to get to the Tutorial on Movement. Use the user email address and password that was emailed to you from admin@cc4steam.org to log into Minecraft. This information will be provided after you have paid your registration fee.



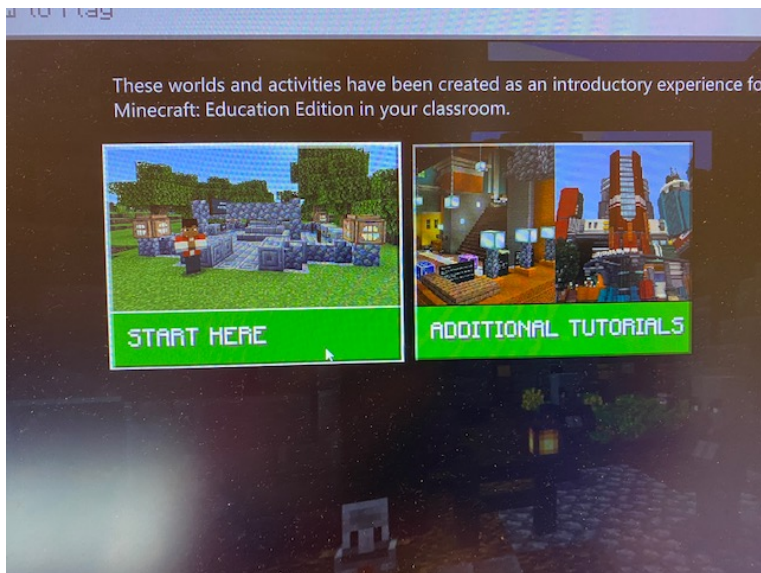

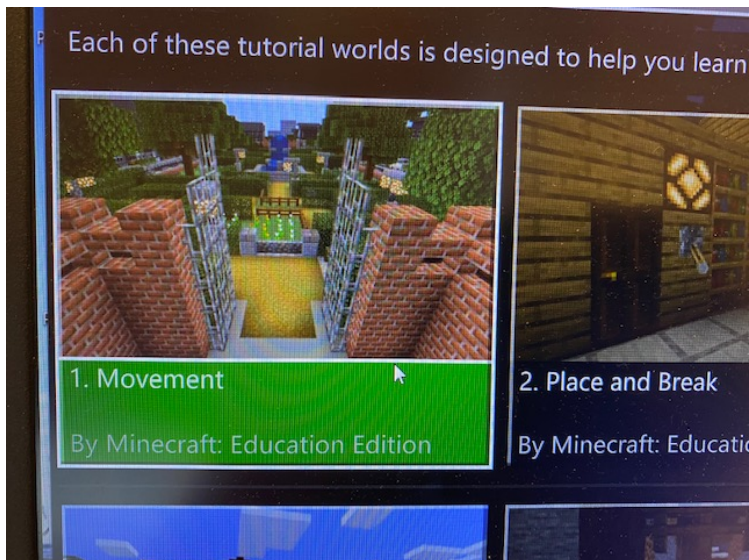
